A. **2021-301** Georgia Public Safety Officials and First Responders Supplement Grant Application

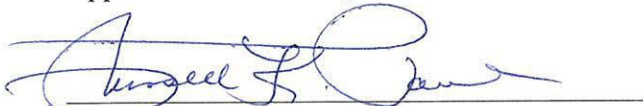
Samantha Dulac, Assistant to the City Manager, presented the City of Sandy Springs' Georgia Public Safety Officials and First Responders Supplement Grant application. The grant provides a \$1,000, one-time pay supplement for full-time, certified police officers and firefighters who have been employed with the City since August 1, 2021. The City will apply for this grant on behalf of its 151 eligible employees. The estimated total amount the City would receive is \$162,551.50, which includes an additional \$76.50 per employee for Medicare and OSADI reimbursement. There are no local matching funds required for this grant. Staff recommends applying for the Georgia Public Safety Officials and First Responders Supplement Grant.
