STAFF DISCUSSION ITEMS

Public Works

1. **17-249** List of Roadways for the Fiscal Year 2018 CIP Resurfacing

Director of Public Works Garrin Coleman stated this agenda item is a paving list of approximately sixteen miles of roadways. Staff proposes these roadways to be let in a package and hopes to have these out to bid in late August 2017. The roadwork should begin this fall and be completed in spring 2018. He requested that Council approve this list.

Council Member John Paulson stated there is also the TSPLOST work to be done. He asked if staff has cross checked these items with the TSPLOST items to make sure we are not going to pave a road twice.

Director of Public Works Coleman stated staff will verify that list as well as have the stormwater staff check the culverts under the roadways to ensure they are repaired before the road is paved.

Council Member Gabriel Sterling stated the City is keeping its word to the citizens when the TSPLOST was passed, that the City would not use these funds this as a replacement, but would spend CIP funds for certain items while spending TSPLOST funds for the designated projects.

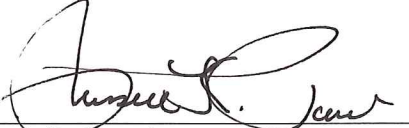
Council Member Tibby DeJulio asked when the paving will begin.

Director of Public Works Coleman stated the project will begin in about two months.

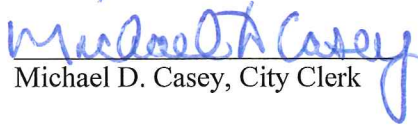
There was a consensus of Council to move forward with the list of roadways for the fiscal year 2018 CIP resurfacing.
