STAFF DISCUSSION ITEMS

Public Works

1. 18-270 Spalding Drive at Pitts Road Intersection Improvement

TSPLOST Project Manager Joe Gillis gave the Spalding Dr. at Pitts Rd. Intersection Improvement PowerPoint Presentation.

Mayor Pro tem John Paulson stated this project is located in his district. He has attended a couple of the neighborhood meetings. Those neighbors that are affected by this on the south side of Spalding Drive have discussed the apparent steepness of the driveways. He asked if the neighbors agreed with the proposed concept plan.

TSPLOST Project Manager Gillis stated a meeting was held on July 11th and the residents who have been involved were invited. The residents like the sidewalk and wall concept. They are concerned about how much useable land will be available and how much they will lose in the right-of-way. There will also be another wall located on Pitts Road. Staff assured the residents that staff will minimize the taking for the right-of-way. Staff conveyed to the citizens there is a great benefit to having the turn lanes. Staff has developed a concept to address the concerns of the property owner with the one driveway that will be very steep.

There was a consensus of Council for staff to continue moving forward with this intersection improvement project.
