ITEM: Consideration of an Agreement Between the City of Sandy Springs Development Authority and the Sandy Springs Perimeter Civic Fund Inc.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends approval of the agenda item and authorize the Chairman to execute an Agreement with the Sandy Springs Perimeter Civic Fund Inc. ("Fund").

Discussion:

During the December 17 meeting, members of the Development Authority discussed a desire to potentially add to the City's funds by creating a mechanism to accept private donations, and directed Staff to explore options.

To increase the attractiveness to potential private donors, the receiving entity should be able to receive tax-deductible donations per the Internal Revenue Service code. Charitable organizations organized as 501(c)(3)s can receive tax-deductible donations. Staff proposes collaborating with the Sandy Springs Perimeter Civic Fund Inc ("Fund") for this purpose. The Fund has been in existence since 2016 and its primary purpose is to provide college scholarships for Riverwood High School and North Springs High School students. The Fund has partnered with various community groups over the years to manage tax deductible donations for other projects in Sandy Springs. To cover the administrative costs associated with these various community projects, the fund has historically charged a 3% fee on donations they manage.
